

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

RESIDENTIAL AND MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE COLLECTION, TRANSPORTATION AND DISPOSAL AND RECYCLABLES COLLECTION FROM APPROXIMATELY 1,325 RESIDENTIAL ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER MOUNT BETHEL

Sealed bids to furnish Residential and Municipal Solid Waste Collection, Transportation and Disposal and Recyclables Collection will be received by the Township of Lower Mount Bethel, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, until noon local time, on October 14, 2026 12:00 p.m. at the Township Office, 2004 Hutchison Avenue (P.O. Box 257), Martins Creek, PA 18063. All bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Centerfield Building, 6984 S. Delaware Drive, Martins Creek, PA 18063 at 1:00 p.m. local time, October 14, 2026.

Copies of the Bid Documents and complete specifications may be obtained from the Township office beginning immediately between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. or by downloading them from the Township website, www.lowermtbethel.org. All bids shall be tendered on the forms provided by the Township in a sealed envelope bearing the bidder's name and address and shall be marked "PROPOSAL FOR MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND RECYCLABLES COLLECTION FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER MOUNT BETHEL".

A mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting will be held on September 28, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. local time at the Centerfield Building, 6984 S. Delaware Drive, Martins Creek, PA 18063. Attendance at the Pre-Bid Meeting will be required for a bid to be considered.

Each bid must be accompanied by either a cashier's check or bid bond, payable to the Township, in the amount of ten (10%) percent of the highest sum of the "Total Prices" bid amount set forth in the bid. Said amount shall guarantee that in the event the contract is awarded to the bidder, the bidder will execute the contract in good faith. Checks or bonds will be returned to all bidders within ten (10) days after the contract is executed by the successful bidder. Attorneys-in-fact who sign bid bonds must file with each bond a certified and effectively dated copy of their power of attorney which effectively provides the necessary legal authority to execute all such documents. The power of attorney shall be subject to the approval of the Township Solicitor.

The Township reserves the right to waive any irregularities in any bid, and to reject any or all bids, or to accept any bid which is in the Township's best interest, as more fully set forth in the Instructions to Bidders. Following the opening of the bids, no bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days.
